
Libraesva ESG allows full user messages customization as well as white labeling feature, by uploading your own logo.

User Message Customization

A full set of pre-defined messages is present in Libraesva ESG. These messages can be fully customized my selecting menù *System->Appliance->Logo and Messages*.

The screen is divided in several Tabs, grouping messages types:





The Tabs and messages available are:

Signatures

These are footer messages. Libraesva ESG appends by default for any incoming and outgoing message a disclaimer. You can Disable whole footers by clicking Disable.

Content Filtering

These messages are sent to users in attachment to any email with a blocked content (i.e. Viruses, Blocked Files) in replacement of the original attachment.

MCP Messages

These messages are sent to users when MCP Actions triggered are *Bounce* or *Notify*.

Spam Messages

These messages are sent to users when Spam Actions triggered are *Attachment*, *Notify*, *Bounce*.

Notifications to Senders

These messages are sent back to sender of blocked files or viruses if enabled.

• Inline Phishing

These strings are pre-pended in red as an inline warning to an html link when Antiphishing Checks are enabled and triggered.

QuickSand

These messages are sent to users in attachment to any email with a blocked or disarmed content from QuickSand in replacement/addition of the original attachment.

• Encryption

These templates are used when an encrypted message is sent.


NOTE: Most of above notifications are customizable with some variables that will be valorized at runtime. See **Variables Help Tab** for instructions.
