

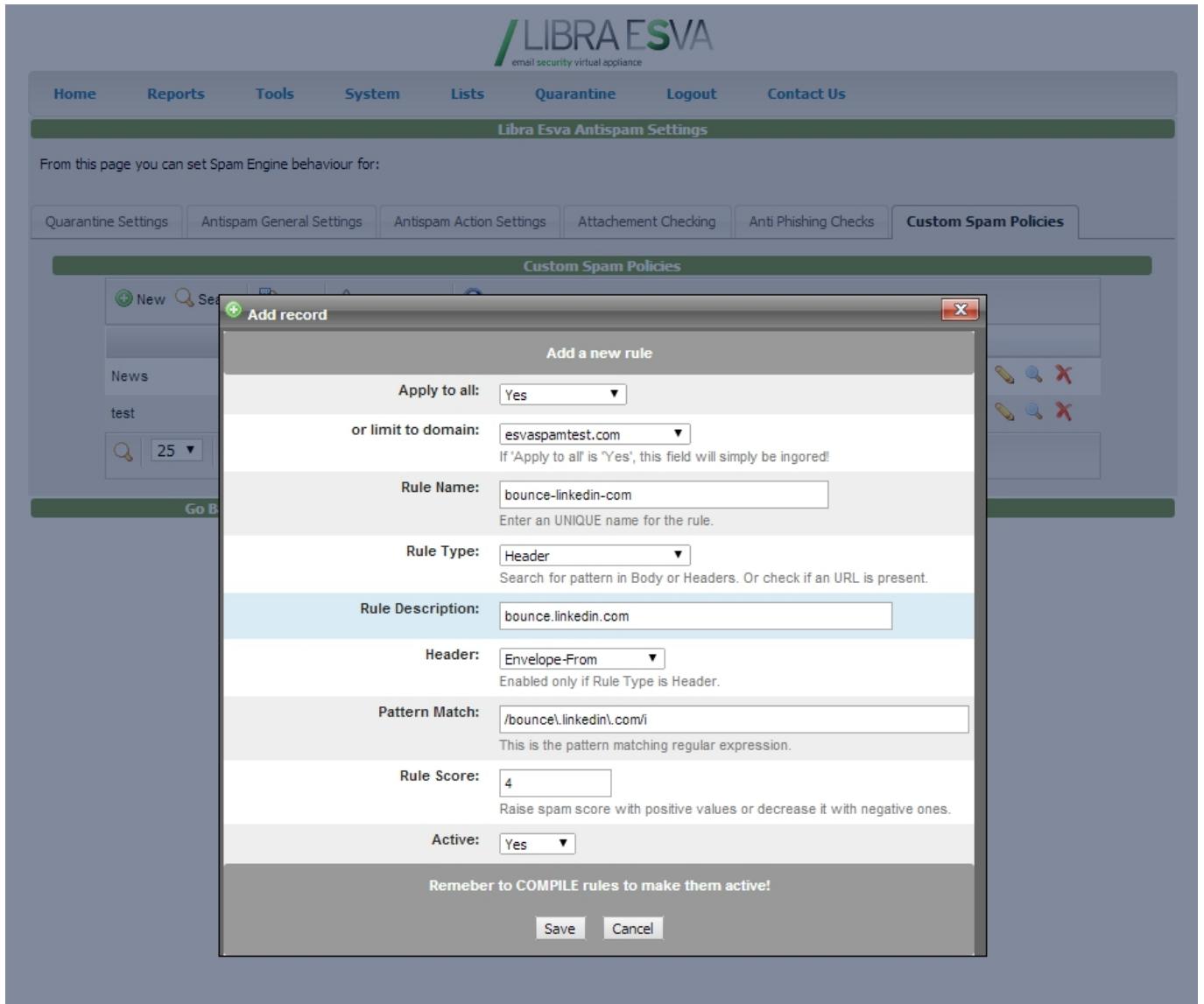

Libra Esva introduced, in version 4.x, a graymailing (advertising) plugin which can be enabled or disabled in System->Content Analysis->Anti-Spam Settings->Antispam General Settings. This plugin blocks only advertising messages and is a no-brainer solution to the problem.

In version version 3.x the administrator can create custom spam rules to mitigate the advertising email issue by blocking specific senders, here are some examples:

t.contactlab.it (regex: /t\.contactlab\.it/i)
amazon (regex /amazon/i)
booking.com (regex /booking\.com/i)
groupon (regex: /groupon/)
badoo (regex: /badoo/i)
mailup con i domini .rxx.it (regex: /\.r\d\d\.it/i)
facebookmail.com (regex: /facebookmail\.com/i)
bounce.linkedin.com (regex: /bounce\.linkedin\.com/i)
mailjet.com (regex: /mailjet\.com/i)
bloomberg.net (regex: /bloomberg\.net/i)
mega-offerta.it (regex: /mega-offerta\.it/i)
expedia (regex: /expedia\.i)
groupalia (regex: /groupalia/i)
HI-Sender (regex: /emailsp\.net/i)
pazzixsconti (regex: /pazzixsconti\.it/i)
scontissimi.me (regex: /scontissimi\.me/i)
bounce.n.dalani.it (regex: /bounce\.n\.dalani\.it/i)
