










# Email Continuity

You can access this feature from the message details.

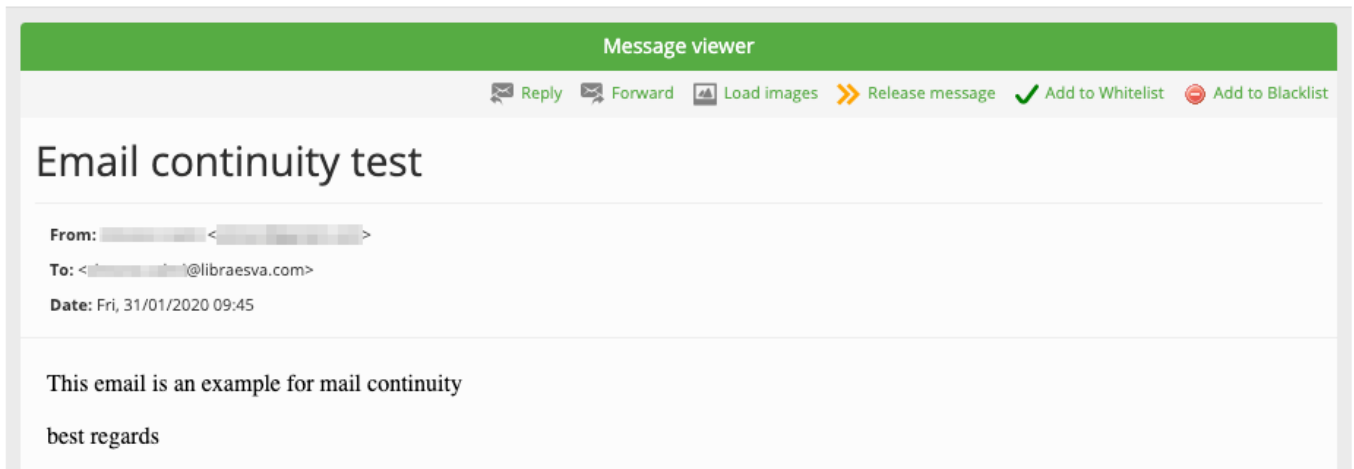

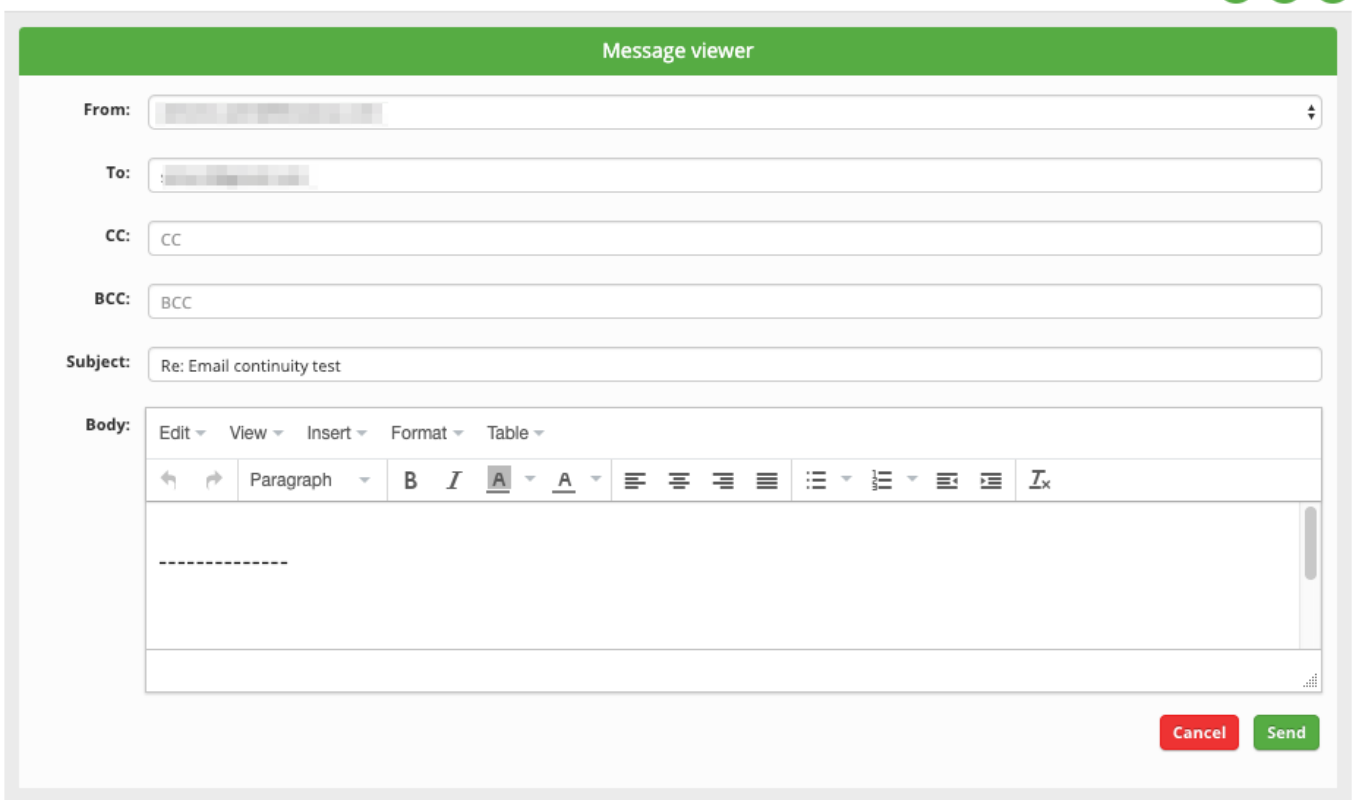
